## **South High Community Band COVID-19 Preparedness Statement**

## Responsibilities of the board:

- Provide masks and bell covers for all band members.
- Provide sanitary means of spit disposal.
- Notify close contacts of anyone who tests positive for COVID-19 while maintaining the individual's confidentiality.
- Provide means for additional spacing of band members.
- Maintain updated preparedness policies as the situation continues to change.

## Responsibilities of band members:

- Provide proof of COVID-19 Vaccination original series only.
- Stay home if you are sick. Please be mindful of any/all symptoms of COVID-19 and DO NOT come to band if you are having ANY symptoms that are unusual for you.
- If you test positive for COVID-19, do not attend band until after your 10 day isolation period. Day 0 is the first day of symptoms or the day of positive test.
- Stay home if you have been exposed to anyone who tested positive for COVID-19. You may return to band 5 days after exposure assuming you are not ill.
- Stay home if you have a pending COVID-19 test.
- Wear KN95 or surgical mask when not playing an instrument.
- Use bell covers while playing an instrument (excludes clarinets) when Hennepin County COVID transmission levels are at MEDIUM or HIGH. When county levels are LOW, bell covers do not need to be used.
- Clarinets will be adequately spaced (ideally 6 feet apart).
- Utilize sanitary means of spit disposal.
- Notify your section leader or a board member if you test positive for COVID-19 to enable contact tracing.

## In case of non-compliance:

• If you are not able to comply with these requirements, you will not be able to participate in band at this time.
